- ❑ **First Place** **Room 207**
First Place is a Christ-centered health program for women of all ages. - ❑ **Grief Share** **Room 206**
If you have lost a spouse, child, family member or friend, you've probably found there are not many people who understand your deep hurt. You may feel isolated and deeply hurt. This course will help students move through the process of grief recovery. - ❑ **Christian Finances I – Your Attitude Toward God's Money** **Sanctuary (Left)**
